

The Mickleborough Solution



I have booked the southern work bay between 4 and 6pm for Sunday races in future.

To accommodate all possible yachts, I have shown a plan which can work with your co-operation

1 and 2 are Yknot and SteadFast with marina berths. 3-4 could be L'attitude, Axiom, Aeolus or Inception (the 40+ footers). 5, 6, 7 and 8 will be smaller yachts.

So, the 40+ footers will be at the dock and other yachts outside. L'attitude will direct yachts and prefers the southern dock position (4). L'attitude is also exempt from buoy pick-up.

We can maintain our COVID plan by crew remaining separated in the cockpit of each boat. Some boats may choose to go to their moorings and will sit on the foredecks on yachts at the dock maintaining social distances and be present for the presentation.

The results will be done on L'attitude and the announcements and presentation "Jug" to the winner on TCF made over a loud hailer.

I expect we should be in position by 5:00pm and the presentation done by 5:30pm giving time for yachts to return to their mooring by 6pm for the tender which closes at 6 but will be extended if required.

Please ensure all yachts rafted and crew returning from mooring are present by 5:15 in order for the presentation to go smoothly and on time

I suggest all yachts cater with drinks and nibbles for their crew as it is a long way back to the club.
