

## SOME INFORMATION RE RMYC-PORT HACKING SAILING PHOTOGRAPHS

### 1. I have some photos that I want to publish/load up onto the sailing web page.

- i. Log In: [treasurer@sailing-rmycph.org.au](mailto:treasurer@sailing-rmycph.org.au)  
PW: Members1\*
- ii. Click on “UpArrow in Cloud” in the right-hand top corner to Upload photos.
- iii. Click - *Choose photos to upload* – select from your PC/folder
- iv. Select Add to Albums in LH column
- v. Select the folder which corresponds to the day of the Race. E.g. 16 December 2020 will be in folder “2020Dec16” & click done.
- vi. Click *Public* and *Upload*
- vii. Click – *Upload “99” photos* – top RH corner (“99” is the number of photos you are uploading)
- viii. Click *Public*.
- ix. Go to *Albums* in Top Ribbon – *select Album just uploaded to*
- x. For your photos uploaded, click on photo to edit details. Before photo number please insert the race date ‘YYYYMMDD’ and under Add Description insert Yacht name(s) separated by semi-colon. Where the photo is of several yachts, insert “General”. DO NOT AMEND ANY PRE-EXISTING PHOTOS.
- xi. When finished editing photo – click “Done” and move onto next photo until you have updated each of your photos.
- xii. Provided the album has been loaded on the Sailing website (this may take a couple of days from race day depending on movements of web-master & main photographer); your photos will be part of that race days photos on the sailing website. You may need to refresh your webbrowser.

Remember – by uploading photos to the Sailing Web, you agree to forgo any rights you have to those photos, understanding other members may download, print, etc.

### 2. I want to find a photo of my yacht and get it printed up.

To do this follow these steps.

1. Go to Flickr.com
2. Log in - User: [treasurer@sailing-rmycph.org.au](mailto:treasurer@sailing-rmycph.org.au)  
Password: *Members1\**
3. Search - on “Yacht Name – e.g. *Majella*”
4. Flickr will return - photos where “Your Yacht” is featured. Peruse photos
5. Pick your favorite photo - you can then download it & get it printed up.

These photos are same resolution as the original photo. Where the photograph is taken close to ‘Your Yacht’ you’ll get the better resolution as opposed to when a long way away & full telephoto has been used.
